ACSM/NSPS Brief History

- ACSM began in 1941 as three divisions:
 - ▶ Land Survey Division, Control Survey Division, Mapping Division
- ▶ 1981: ACSM forms into three Member Organizations (MOs)
 - ► National Society of Professional Surveyors (*NSPS*)
 - American Association of Geodetic Surveyors (AAGS)
 - ► Cartographic and Geographic Information Society (CaGIS)
- ▶ 1991 (+/-): NSPS incorporated to facilitate separate budget \$
- ▶ 2006 (+/-): New ACSM Congress Format
- 2012 (+/-): Disolved ACSM and formed into separate associations of: NSPS, AAGS, CaGIS

NSPS Defends our Profession

Davis-Bacon Act

NSPS continues to gain support in its challenge of the U. S. Department of Labor's All Agency Memorandum No. 212 (AAM 212) which was issued March 22, 2013. Curt has testified in Congress on behalf of NSPS.

Improper Contracting Procedures - QBS

The procurement of professional surveying services (federal Brooks Act - "mini-Brooks Acts" in the respective states), is to be conducted using Qualifications Based Selection (QBS) procedures rather that soliciting bids from professional surveyors. We continue to assist surveyors around the country by contacting the offending agencies and requesting them to withdraw the offending RFP and replace it with the QBS system. This can happen 20 to 30 times a year.

GPS - Lightsquared and GPS issues, battles, and alliances

NSPS won the first battle, teaming with the Military to defend the GPS broadband width, but we must remain ever vigilant to monitor and build alliances, as Lightsquared has not gone away.

NSPS Defends our Profession (continued)

General Advocacy

JGAC

Joint Government Affairs Committee monitors, reviews, makes recommendations, and works with our lobbyist to present the NSPS position on all surveying related legislative issues. They also monitor, respond as requested, and enforces the Qualification Base Selection System.

NCEES

NSPS is a member of the NCEES Participating Organizations Liaison Council (POLC), and is an active participant in the NCEES Surveyors Forum. Curt has also been appointed to the NCEES Future of Surveying Task force.

ABET

ABET is the organization that provides accreditation for educational programs leading to professional careers in surveying (and engineering/technology disciplines). NSPS supports and supplies several Program Evaluators to act as our advocates in the review of the multiple 4yr degree programs. Engineers may be interested to take this over if we are not vigilant.

Scholarships

How many members does NSPS now have, and how does this compare with prior to the 100% Joint Membership Program?

Currently, with 47 States (CO. being the most recent), joint membership is nearly 15,000 +/-, as compared with below 4,000 +/- at lowest.

Yes it does, as *NSPS* begins to send its weekly email newsletter (*NSPS News & Views*) to this new larger joint membership of state societies.
