- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 if currently enrolled in a degree seeking program or high school.

Submittals

Please submit the following:

- A completed Joint Scholarship Application.
- A 200 word paper discussing why surveying is important to your career goals and how the course work to which this scholarship will apply will help you attain your goals.
- All official college transcripts or high school transcripts if still in high school. (Not applicable for those who graduated more than 4 years ago.)
- A letter of recommendation from your faculty advisor, one of your professors, your employer, or your sponsor addressed to Western Colorado Land Surveyors, Scholarship Committee at the address listed below.
- A list of any academic honors, scholarships, community service, volunteer work, or awards received since entering high school.
- A list of any applicable job experience, involvement with civic and professional associations, and your plans after graduation or completion of the coursework. An oral interview may be required to determine the successful applicant or applicants.

Evaluation and Selection

The selection will be performed by the Western Colorado Land Surveyors Scholarship Committee. The committee will use the following Rubric to rate the submitted documents for selection.

Paper = 50% with Transcripts, 67% if transcripts are not applicable.

Transcript and Grades = 25% with Transcripts, 0% if transcripts are not applicable.

Other documents = 25% with Transcripts, 33% if transcripts are not applicable.
