2020 MAP/PLAT DESIGN COMPETITION

Entries will be judged by representatives from the PLSC chapters and winners will be announced at the Rocky Mountain Surveyor Summit. The judging criteria will include content, data relevance, accuracy of scale, layout innovation, interpretability, applicability, and neatness in presentation.

Entrants need not be PLSC members; however, entries must be sponsored by a PLSC member. PLSC members may self sponsor. Entrants must have contributed in the production of the entry.

Hand drafted or computer generated maps and plats completed after 6/30/2018 are eligible for entry. No more than two entries per category will be considered for each entrant.

Entries can be color or monochrome and should conform to standard industry or jurisdictional size requirements as applicable. For hand drafted entries, submit a single copy of the original up to a maximum size of 34" by 44". Entries will become property of PLSC and hard copy entries will not be returned.

In the case of multiple sheet entries, the set can be submitted, however due to limited display space at the summit only two sheets for each winning entry will be on display. Please indicate which two sheets you would like to be printed and displayed on the submission form. If sheets are not indicated, the judges will pick their top two. All entries must be received by 5 pm on February 22, 2020.
